Tips for what to bring:

- Comfortable walking shoes.
- Light clothes and long trousers.
- Hat and rain cape (material that breathes is best, because of the humidity; sometimes an umbrella is most comfortable but on tracks through bushes sometimes difficult to keep up).
- Personal medication.
- Sun lotion, insect repellent.
- A compass, if you walk around on your own.
- Travel light: waterproof rucksack or bag for your personal luggage and equipment. You may leave your big suitcase at our Medan office and just take along what you need for a couple of days in Bukit La wang.

Visa: visa on arrival

This visa can be obtained directly when you are landed at the certain airports and seaports in Indonesia. The maximum stays permitted for the visa on arrival is 30 days.

The general requirements for visa on arrival are:

- Expiration date of the applicant's passport must be at least 6(six) months at the date of entry.
- Round-trip airplane ticket
- Fees

The fees for visa on arrival are:

- Visa for stay up to 30 (thirty) days = US\$ 25.
- Extension of stay for up to 30 (thirty) days = US\$ 25.
